Zoning Administrator: Duane Hagerman reported 2 land splits.

Cemetery Committee: Ray Everingham reported no burials.

Unfinished Business:

Discussed installing flagpole at cemetery with solar light. Discussed salvaging flagpole at school to use at hall.

New Business:

Received question about snow plowing and the enlarged parking lot.

Motion by Ryan, seconded by Hummel to put snow plowing out for bids. Carried.

The township currently pays about \$49 per month for 4 streetlights. Consumers contract received to renew for the next year of street lighting.

Motion by Ryan, seconded by Chapko to re-enter into contract with Consumers for standard street lighting for the next year. Carried.
