The meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM by Supervisor Dan Ryan at Bloomer Township Hall, 9890 E. Carson City Rd, Carson City, MI. Present for roll call were Sarah Todd, Colleen Schneider, Larry Hummel, Tara Chapko, Dan Ryan.

Motion by Hummel, seconded by Chapko to accept the minutes of the November 16, 2015 regular meeting as presented. Carried.

Motion by Hummel, seconded by Schneider to pay bills totaling \$71,190.57. Carried.

Treasurers Report: Colleen Schneider

Balance of \$323,533.90 in general accounts after bills. Summer Taxes 88% and Winter Taxes 20% collected. 44% combined tax yet to collect.

Motion by Ryan, seconded by Todd to accept treasurers report. Carried.

Planning Commission: Doug Proctor working on master plan.

Zoning Administrator: Duane Hagerman responded to complaint about tree, had question about placing mobile home.

Cemetery Committee: Ray Everingham reports gate still open until it snows.

Unfinished Business:

Township hall sign discussed with Midwest Sign and 180 Designs. Hall is in commercial zone so sign can be 32 square feet, will obtain price quotes.

Master Plan needs to be updated. Doug Proctor discussed update with Mark Eidelson of LandPlan. Will take 12 months to complete with 5 phases and 8 meeting times.

Investing in a bank certificate of deposit discussed. Interest rates and terms from 3 banks reviewed. Will wait.

Sadie Oil/Great Lakes Brine provided diagrams of brine well. Requesting approval from township. Letter will be sent of board approval as long as DEQ and other agency requirements are met.

New Business:

Dairyland Excavating provided quote for enlarging parking lot and driveway.

Motion by Schneider, seconded by Todd to approve Dairyland Excavating to widen driveway to 24', expand parking lot by 70'x110' using 100 yds sand, 180 yds 23A gravel, 145 yds crushed asphalt not to exceed \$11,865. Carried.

Snow plowing, shoveling, salting will be provided by Tony Brown for the 2015-16 season at a cost of \$50 per time.

Motion by Hummel, seconded by Chapko to approve budget amendments. Carried.

Received quote from Gage Electric for lights for parking lot and lights for sign/flagpole. Will wait until more sign information is received.
