Motion by Hummel, seconded by Chapko to enter into agreement with city of Carson City for water and sanitary sewer as recommended by legal counsel. Motion carried.

Discussed numerous complaints regarding refuse and inoperable vehicles.

Motion by Hummel, seconded by Ryan to contact lawyer to send letters to 3 offenders. Carried.

Flagpole and outside lights discussed.

Mount Hope Road improvements discussed.

Motion by Ryan, seconded by Hummel to pay for Montcalm County Road Commission to crush, shape and repave Mount Hope Road from Fenwick Road to Dailey Road in 2017 not to exceed \$118,000 to be repaid within 2 years. Carried.
