Motion by Hummel, seconded by Chapko to accept the minutes of the March 19, 2018 regular meeting with correction. Carried.

Planning Commission: Doug Proctor reported meeting April 10, 2018 for public hearing on Sign Ordinance. Master Plan changes discussed, of leaving prison in agricultural. Next regular meeting May 8, 2018.

Cemetery Committee: Ray Everingham reported cemetery reopened March 31.

Unfinished Business:

Discussed meeting with sheriff, prosecutor, road commission, Bloomer, Crystal, Evergreen and Bushnell townships regarding road damage from tires with metal. Memo from sheriff states MCL 257.710 will be enforced.

Plan as follows: southeast corner of Garlock and M-57 change from suburban residential to commercial, east to Bloomer Street and south to industrial. Carried.

Motion by Ryan, seconded by Todd to approve Gage Electric contract for installing poles and outside lights at township hall. Carried.

Discussed road contracts for the upcoming year. Will receive matching funds for brush spray and 10% matching funds for construction projects.

Motion by Ryan, seconded by Hummel to approved the following contracts with the road commission: gravel Bogart from Sloan to Crystal \$10,289, gravel Sloan from County Line to Bogart \$8,455, gravel Bogart from Senator to Sloan \$10,289, pave Waldron from Bogart to Fenwick \$129,106, crack seal \$8,625, brush spray \$2,000. Carried.
