Solar/Wind Ordinance discussed. Contact with township attorney resulted in recommending no changes.

**Motion** by Hummel, seconded by Chapko to approve Solar/Wind Ordinance as recommended by the Planning Commission.

**Public Comment:** Much discussion and public comments from zoom participants regarding wind ordinance. Hummel withdrew/recinded motion to wait one more month.

Zoning Administrator/Officer position vacant. One application received. Advertised once in Daily News and once in Gratiot County Herald with no results.

**Motion** by Ryan, seconded by Hummel to place a larger add for 2 weeks in the Gratiot County Herald and the Daily News. Carried.
