

Bloomer Township Regular Meeting January 16, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Supervisor Dan Ryan at Bloomer Township Hall, 9890 E. Carson City Rd, Carson City, MI. Present for roll call were Colleen Schneider, Tara Chapko, Dana Gonzales, Dan Ryan, Larry Hummel

Motion by Gonzales second by Ryan to accept the minutes of the December 19, 2022 regular meeting as presented. Carried.

Fire Department: Mark Crawfis reported. Fire department is at 64 reported runs for the 2022. Finished the Annual report, if anyone would like an emailed copy please contact him. The fire department is once again partnered with red cross to install up to 3 smoke detectors per house. Contact the fire department to have the fire department install them at no cost.

County Commissioner: Chris Johnston reported. Commissioner meetings will be held the 2nd and 4th Monday at 4pm. These will constitute full board meetings with actions being taken. Chair and vice chair remained the same. They have offered the previous animal control officer an offer to return. She starts the 20th of January.

Citizens Comments: E.J. Horricks discussed a raise of 10% for the board as it has been several years since one was instituted.

Clerks Report: Tara Chapko reported. CMS has installed internet and set up Microsoft 365. Bendon heating and cooling replaced the burner on the furnace and changed the filter. Assembled year end totals for tax papers. Motion by Hummel second by schneider to approve as presented. Motion carried.

Motion by Hummel, second by Schneider to pay bills totaling \$12451.70. Motion carried.

Treasurers Report: Colleen Schneider-After all known bills and utilities clear available funds will be \$998,781.40. Motion by Chapko, second by Hummel to accept report as presented. Motion Carried.

Zoning Administrator: One zoning permit.

Planning Commission: Meeting was January 10, 2023 discussed set back conformities and looking at mobile home age will need to discuss and send a request after the March 14, 2023 meeting to Fahey to formalize and set date for public hearing in April possibly. Doug will be gone in February.

Cemetery Sexton: Issac Torres- 1 full burial January 4th. Opened and closed the cemetery for the service. Cemetery meeting will be February 6, 2023.

Unfinished Business: Motion by Hummel second by Schneider to Have Boge, Wybenga & Bradley, PC do our annual audit for \$7150. Motion carried. Motion by Chapko, second by Schneider to have our auditors also review and update Michigan chart of accounts for \$750. Motion carried.

New Business: Heard from Mark Sabin director of Montcalm Solid waste committee about recycling. They have hosted tire and electronic recycling with much success. In 2022 they took in 791000#'s. They are looking to put in a 3rd recycling compactor possibly in Carson City which limits contamination. They are asking for \$5000 from several townships to help defray cost. The county has dedicated \$40,000. Motion by Ryan, second by Chapko to commit to \$5000.00 after the start of our new fiscal year. Motion carried.

Salary resolutions were discussed Motion by Schneider, second by Hummel to approve as presented. Motion carried.
