

Bloomer Township Regular Meeting April 17, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by supervisor Dan Ryan at Bloomer Township Hall, 9890 E. Carson City Rd, Carson City, MI. Present for roll call were Colleen Schneider, Tara Chapko, Dana Gonzales, Larry Hummel and Dan Ryan

Motion by Hummel second by Schneider to accept the minutes of the March 20, 2023 regular meeting as presented. Carried.

Fire Department: Mark Crawfis reported. Have reported over 23 calls to date. Responded to mutual aid requests from Hubbardston and Sheridan. Has met with the GESA board. Possible 2 new recruits.

County Commissioner: Chris Johnston reported. The county commissioners have received the blight ordinance for the county and are looking it over. Discussion was held on combining the 2 clerks offices into 1. No action has been taken at this time. Animal Control are looking to apply for grants for the spray and neuter program and also applying for a grant for cat cages.

Clerks Report: Tara Chapko reported. Answered emails, set up June 10 with Granger for spring cleanup. Have received the flags for the cemetery for the veterans. Working on AV for the May 2 election. Sold cemetery plots. Motion by Hummel, second by Gonzales to accept the clerks report as presented. Motion carried.

Motion Motion by Hummel, 2nd by Schneider to pay bills totaling \$10,647.39. Motion carried.

Treasurers Report: Colleen Schneider reported. After all known bills and utilities clear available funds will be \$1,075,260.89. Motion by Chapko, second by Gonzales to accept report as presented. Motion carried.

Zoning Administrator: One permit. Several inquiries about land splits.

Planning Commission: Doug received Fahey's wording for the mobile home ordinance. Distributed copies to the township board and will get to the planning commission members for them to look over at their next meeting on May 9th.

Cemetery Sexton: Issac Torres reported. Cemetery was open for the season on March 31st. Will do general yard work and start mowing soon.

Unfinished Business: Road contracts. Motion by Ryan, second by Hummel to approve Spending \$402,625.15 in road contracts as follows: seal coat with fog seal Garlock road from Condensory road 1.0 mile south, seal coat with fog seal Condensory road from Mount Hope road east to end of pavement, gravel resurface with limestone Sessions road from Sloan road to Waldron road, gravel resurface with limestone Waldron road from Sessions road to Condensory road, gravel resurface Sloan road from Boyer road to M-57, gravel resurface Sloan road from Fenwick road to Boyer road, gravel resurface Boyer road from Sloan road to Crystal road, gravel resurface Boyer road from Senator road to Sloan road, Overband crack Seal locations, Asphalt overlay on Sloan road from M-57 to Sessions road, Asphalt overlay on Garlock road from M-57 to Rustic drive, 3 applications of chloride, 40 hours of ditching along local roads, spray brush along local roadsides. Motion carried.

New Business: Discussion was held regarding the cemetery committee. Having accomplished what the committee was formed to do Motion by Chapko, second by Schneider to dissolve the committee. Motion carried.

Announcements: Spring Clean up will be June 10, 2023. Here at the hall from 8am-noon.
