Fire Department: Mark Crawfis reported. Have reported 39 calls for the year. Attended monthly meetings. Department supported Frontiers day parades, the picnic and fireworks events. Chief filled 2 swimming pools. 19 personnel with 3 being probationary.

County Commissioner: Chris Johnston reported. County commissioners have approved 1.4million to improve security and update cameras, etc at court complex. Approved contract for construction for housing clerks records. Other, business as usual.

Zoning Administrator: 2 new zoning permits issued. One for an elevated deck and one for a storage building for Paddle King. On June 28th gave a warning for a perpetual yard sale. Kevin Smith has sent out paperwork to some parties, the township has not received any as of tonight's meeting. Discussion about sending paperwork to neighbors. Need to set a special use permit with the Board of appeals. Need to contact Fahey on fee list for citations.

Planning Commission: Doug reported the planning commission held their regular meeting on the 11th. Next meeting will be September 12, 2023.

Cemetery Sexton: Mowing and weed whipping. Foundation on June 29th.
