

Bloomer Township Regular Meeting April 21, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM by Supervisor Dan Ryan at Bloomer Township Hall, 9890 E. Carson City Rd, Carson City, MI. Present for roll call were Colleen Schneider, Tara Chapko, Dana Gonzales, Larry Hummel and Dan Ryan.

Addition to agenda: none

Motion by Hummel, second by Schneider to accept the minutes of the March 17, 2025 regular meeting as presented. Carried.

Fire Department: 4 calls for the month, 18 reported calls year to date. No personnel changes to report 16 total. The chief was unable to attend meetings as he was instructing a firefighter 2 course. Handled maintenance issues. Fire training was conducted on March 12th and 19th.

County Commissioner: Chris Johnston reported. Approved a variance for a Crystal Lake resident, approved jail and COA projects, approved revised police contracts with much discussion, approved 4 community grants and was advised of \$9,000,000 being spent on road work in the county.

Clerks Report: Tara Chapko reported. Sent out PA116 paperwork, accepted payment for burial, letter of support for CMS fiberoptics in rural areas, Spoke to Hartleb on FOIA request, they filled out and I emailed the paperwork, filled out forfeiture and election surveys, ordered camera and computer for election mandates, received notice of drain work sec 14, 17, and 23 finished putting the budget into BS&A. Motion by Hummel, 2nd by Gonzales to pay bills totaling \$23976.75. Motion carried.

Treasurers Report: Colleen Schneider reported. After all known bills and utilities clear available funds will be \$1,155,123.64. Motion by Chapko, 2nd by hummel to accept report as presented. Motion carried.

Planning Commission: Doug was absent. John Dennis ran the meeting. Heard reports of wind turbine interest. Next meeting May 13th at 7pm.

Zoning Administrator: Tony reported 1 permit and reissue of 1 permit. Spoke with and accepted application for Taco Bell.

Sexton and Maintenance: Issac Torres reported. April 7th hung burn sign and fixed the main cemetery sign, April 16 foundation for Hubler

Unfinished business: approved Road Contracts-Brush spraying, ditching, chloride, limestone- Condensery from Mt. Hope to E. County Line rd., - Sloan rd. from Fenwick to M57 – Sessions Waldron to Miner , 200 tons of limestone for maintenance at locations to be determined by the Montcalm road commission in total of \$335,130. The road commission will be doing \$100,000 for those townships that do multiple road work.

New Business: Taco Bell, LLC has filed a land split and is requesting a special use permit as well as a variance to erect a taco bell in front of Village Market. Need to notify BOA members and publish it 15days prior.
