Addition to agenda: Hummel added Discussion of generator and pairing with the Carson City Police department to the agenda. Motion to accept agenda as amended. Carried.

Approved a bid to finish paint railings, bed frames and other metal items in the jail, approved a 7 cent per meal increase in inmate meals, approved an early pay scale jump for admin.aid in clerks office due to added responsibilities and experience above a new hire level.
