The meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM by supervisor Dan Ryan at Bloomer Township Hall, 9890 E. Carson City Rd, Carson City, MI. Present for roll call were Colleen Schneider, Tara Chapko, Dana Gonzales, Larry Hummel and Dan Ryan.

Motion by Hummel, second by Schneider to accept the minutes of the July 15, 2024 regular meeting as presented. Carried.

Fire Department: Mark Crawfis reported. 33 calls total for the year, 6 for July. Chief attended township and city council meetings. Also attended county 911 authority board meeting. Attended the light parade in Crystal on the 3rd and parade on the fourth. Handled maintenance issues. Conducted fire training on July 10th and 17th. Maintenance was completed on the 12th and did draft training with engine 1 on the 19th. 2 applicants for personnel interviews in August.
